Questions for Life: Increasing Critical Thinking

Teachers use their questions to generate student thinking to promote quality learning. When students learn to ask their own questions, learning is generated. Increasing the depth of content requires quality questioning. Questions for Life (QfL) provides a framework using 11 questioning strategies to guide and facilitate the critical thinking process. Teachers can use QfL to model real-life problem-solving protocols within content instruction. School leaders can use the same process to facilitate teacher thinking in coaching settings and professional learning communities.
